Engine:

- Blueprinted, Gas Flowed heads, Billet cam covers with clear windows, Billet engine transparent cases (alternator, clutch, water pump and gear cases) in black, Billet waterpump elbow, Billet large oil sump, SAMCO silicone hose kit, ACCEL 8.8mm plug wires, Billet engine crash protectors, Titanium bolt kit (engine & frame)
- KEIHIN FCR 39mm Racing carbs, with polished and black powder coated manifolds, NOS System with 2 EDELBROOK small Bottles & billet brackets. 143.8RWHP - 192.9RWHP w NOS System
- HINDLE headers, "one off" connector pipe with short baffler 2" end cap

Frame Mods:

- OVER lateral frame reinforcement bars and FORMULA rear set

Front end:

- "One Off" Billet yokes, SHOWA USD forks with 80mm extension and 58mm milled sleeves, Billet instrument panel for Spa Gauges and indicator lights, "Streetfighter" double headlight with 58mm mounting brackets, Billet short handlebar raisers and dragbars

Wheels:

- FORMULA billet 3.5"x17" front & 6"x17" rear wheels and METZELER Sportec M-1 tires

Brakes:

- BERINGER radial, 17.5 bore brake & clutch master cylinders with remote billet reservoir, SPIEGLER 8 pod "racing" callipers with titanium bolts, SPIEGLER 320mm disk and braided lines

Swingarm:

- "one off" FORMULA mono-swingarm with integrated brake system, BREMBO calliper

Shock(s):

- Mono-Shock "one off" WORKS Pro-Racer mono-shock with "piggyback" (compression, rebound damping and spring pre-load adjuster)

Seat:

- "one off"

Gauges:

- SPA Tach/Speedo & dual oil pressure/water temp. gauges, N2S & Fuel pressure gauges

Bodywork:

- "one off" extended tail section with LED integrated running/stop and signal lights, top mounted GOODRIDGE gas filler cap, "one off" Front fender, FORMULA oversize scoops and side covers, OVER Carbon Fibre faux gas tank cover

Billet Parts:

- Billet ignition housing, oil & transmission filler and drain bolts, cylinder side covers, bar ends, shock stoppers and S/S cam cover bolt kit
